



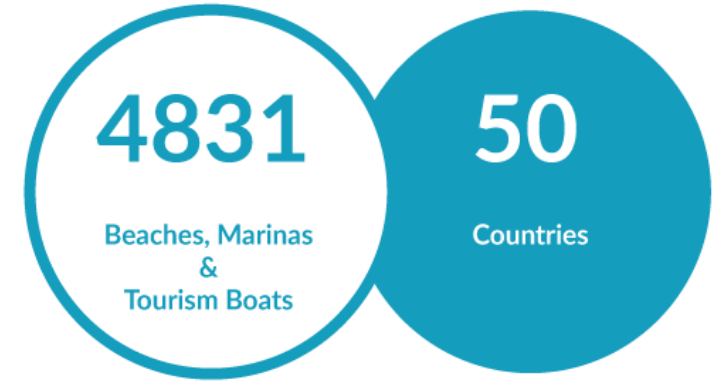

Blue Flag Required Public Information

Several other criteria must be complied with on top of the ones below to qualify for the Blue Flag award

Other required criteria apply, such as lifesaving information, environmental management plan, accessibility.

Criterion 1. Information about the Blue Flag Programme must be displayed.

Criterion 2. Environmental education activities must be offered and promoted to beach users.

Criterion 3. Information about bathing water quality must be displayed.

Criterion 4. Information relating to local eco-systems, environmental elements and cultural sites must be displayed.

Criterion 5. A map of the beach indicating different facilities must be displayed.

Criterion 6. A code of conduct that reflects appropriate laws and/or regulations governing the use of the beach and surrounding areas must be displayed.

Balsio ežero paplūdimys apdovanotas Mėlynąja vėliava – tarptautiniu Aplinkosauginio švietimo fondo (Foundation for Environmental Education - FEE) suteikiamu apdovanojimu.

Balsys lake beach has been given Blue Flag accreditation. Blue Flag is an environmental award, given to communities that make a special effort to manage their coastal/inland water environment and beaches with respect for the local environment and nature.

To attain Blue Flag, the community and its beach operators have to fulfill a number of criteria covering environmental education and information, water quality, safety, service and facilities.

This effort by community ensures that you and your family can expect to visit beaches that meet certain standards regarding cleanliness and safety provisions.

Blue Flag is awarded by the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE), a non-governmental environmental organisation, which is represented by national organisations in each of the participating countries.

Blue Flag is only awarded for one season at a time and the award is valid as long as the criteria are fulfilled. The national FEE organisation monitors Blue Flag sites during the season. For more information and the full set of criteria, visit: www.blueflag.global.

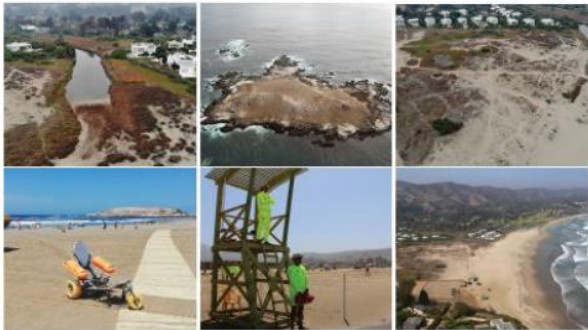

ÁREAS NATURALES SENSIBLES / SENSITIVE NATURAL AREAS

Áreas sensibles naturales: Uno de los tesoros naturales más importantes de la comuna que se encuentra a escasos metros de la playa, es el monumento natural Isla de los Pingüinos de Cachagua, lugar que alberga el 3% de la población mundial de pingüinos de Humboldt, además de pelicanos, gaviotas y chungungos entre otros. Otras áreas naturales que hacen de esta playa un lugar de encuentro, son las dunas de Cachagua y el humedal Santa Rosa, ambos espacios al interior de la playa y que albergan una importante cantidad de especies entre las que se destacan especies vegetales y una gran cantidad de aves como lo son: garzas, queltehués, cormoranes, taguas y otras que dan vida a una de las playas con más encanto de nuestro país.

One of the most important natural treasures of the commune is located a few meters away from the beach. "Isla de los Pingüinos de Cachagua" is a natural monument, home to 3% of the world population of Humboldt penguins, in addition to pelicans, seagulls and chungungos, among others. Other natural areas that make this beach a meeting place are the Cachagua dunes and the Santa Rosa wetland. Both spaces inside the beach area, host a significant number of species, among which stand out plants and a large number of birds such as: herons, queltehués, cormorants, taguas and others, that give life to one of the most charming beaches in our country.

Blue Flag and bathing water quality

Balsys lake beach has meet water quality standards. The bathing water is continuously monitored for the different types of bacteria shown in the tables. The bathing water is monitored every fortnight throughout the season. In the tables you can see when the water has been analyzed and how many bacteria were found.

A small number of bacteria tells you that the water is very clean – a high number of bacteria tell you that the water may be polluted and could contain bacteria from sewage.

CALIDAD DEL AGUA / WATER QUALITY

El agua de baño de esta playa es muestreada durante la temporada de acuerdo a los estándares de calidad de agua Blue Flag. Esta se monitorea continuamente para los diferentes tipos de bacterias que se muestran en las tablas. El agua de baño se prueba al menos cada 30 días. Una pequeña cantidad de bacterias le dice que el agua está limpia; una gran cantidad de bacterias le dice que el agua puede estar contaminada y podría contener bacterias que contienen bacterias de las aguas residuales. La bandera se removerá en caso de incumplimiento de los estándares de calidad del agua.

The water at this beach is sampled during the bathing water season in accordance with the Blue Flag water quality standards. This is continually monitored for the different types of bacteria shown in the tables. The bathing water is tested at least every 30 days. A small number of bacteria tell you that the water is clean - a high number of bacteria tell you that the water may be polluted and could contain bacteria contain bacteria from sewage. The flag will be removed in case of non-compliance with the water quality standards.

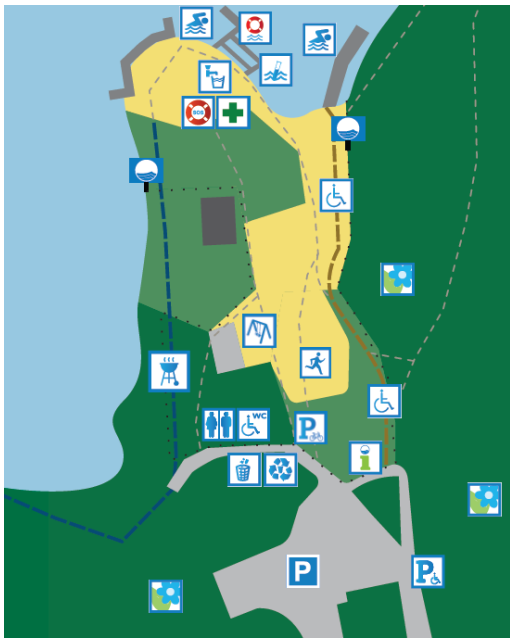

About the site

Cachagua (from the Mapuche Kachue: pastures land), is a four kilometers-long beach, with soft sands, and continuous waves, making it a special place for sports such as surfing, bathing, and other outdoor activities. It is under the protection of the Chilean Navy and the Illustrious Municipality of Zapallar. Cachagua's beach is enabled every year between November 15th and March 15th. During this period, facilities and services are opened to the public, highlighting accessible toilets, coastal walks, an inclusive point with an amphibious chair, lifeguards, in addition to Navy personnel, police, PDI, and municipal officers everyday between 10:00 hrs. and 20:00 hrs.

One of the most important natural treasures of the commune is located a few meters away from the beach. "Isla de los Pingüinos de Cachagua" is a natural monument, home to 3% of the world population of Humboldt penguins, in addition to pelicans, seagulls and chungungos, among others.

Selection of relevant criteria

Criterion 13. The local authority/beach operator must comply with all laws and/or regulations affecting the location and operation of the beach.

Criterion 14. Sensitive areas must be managed.

Criterion 15. The beach must be clean.

Criterion 16. Algal vegetation or natural debris must be left on the beach.

Criterion 17. Waste disposal bins/containers must be available at the beach in adequate numbers, and they must be regularly maintained.

Criterion 18. Facilities for the separation of recyclable waste materials must be available at the beach.

Criterion 19. An adequate number of toilet or restroom facilities must be provided.

Criterion 20. The toilet or restroom facilities must be kept clean.

Criterion 21. The toilet or restroom facilities must have controlled sewage disposal.

Criterion 22. There must be no unauthorized camping or driving and no dumping on the beach.

Criterion 24. All buildings and beach equipment must be properly maintained.

Criterion 25. Marine and freshwater sensitive habitats (such as coral reefs or seagrass beds) in the vicinity of the beach must be monitored.

Criterion 27. Appropriate public safety control measures must be implemented.

Criterion 29. Emergency plans to cope with pollution risks must be in place.

Criterion 30. There must be management of different users and uses of the beach so as to prevent conflicts and accidents.

Criterion 31. There must be safety measures in place to protect users of the beach, and free access must be granted to the public.

Criterion 33. At least one Blue Flag beach in each municipality must have access and facilities provided for the physically disabled.
